CONTRIBUTING TO THE ACCREDITATION COMPLIANCE

In the purpose to comply with HEC accreditation standards, 13 change management projects have been created. We would like to highlight today the achievements made by the project #2 “Organizational structure and RACI” under the responsibility of Mr. Mohammed Yousif.

The project is mainly related to HEC indicators from Area 2 “Academic Management and Administration” and has the objective to contribute to the efficiency of the institution.

Achievements in titles:

1. A new **HR system** has been implemented for HR team and a new Employee Portal has been implemented for all employees (contributing to comply with HEC Area 2/Standard 6 “The institution must be effectively administered”).
2. **Organizational and Physical chart** of the University have been finalized (contributing to comply with HEC Area1/Standard 1 “The institution must be effectively and responsibly governed”): a formal detailed communication to all the staff will be handled by HR during the following weeks.
3. **Job descriptions** for all staff are completed and CVs from academic staff have been finalized with VP Academic (contributing to comply with HEC Area 2/ Standard 7 “The institution must employ appropriately qualified and experienced managerial, administrative and technical staff”): a formal detailed communication to all the staff will be handled by HR during the following weeks.
4. An online access for each **admin employee** to update his/her **CV** through the **Employee Portal**: is under development and will be implemented in the coming 2 weeks.
5. Professional development programs for the HRD administrative team members have been planned (contributing to comply with HEC Area 2/Standard 6 “The institution must be effectively administered”).

The Human Resources Department (HRD) (Administrative Staff Training Unit) is conducting a series of professional development programs for the HRD administrative team members.

The training programs are aimed at uplifting specific skills required by modern day educational bodies. This training plan will start with HRD team members followed by other administrative departments.

Upon successful completion of 2 from the 3 assigned training programs, participants will receive a Continuing Professional Development (CPD) certificate from the Institute of Commercial Management (ICM), an awarding body from the United Kingdom.

RUSSIAN DELEGATION

On 24 and 25 April 2016, Dr Assem Al-Hajj, the Acting President of the University and senior management group of Applied Science University received a Russian Business delegation from St Petersburg headed by Andrey Maksimov, Committee on Science and Higher Education, Government of St. Petersburg.



During the meeting, both parties explored potential opportunities for collaboration between the two institutions and showed interest in cooperation, in providing exchange of students and professors, summer programmes, and expansion.

In the evening, ASU delegation was invited to accompany the Russian delegation to dinner which was organised by the Capital Government.

POLITICAL SCIENCE STUDENTS ORGANISE A WORKSHOP IN INTERNATIONAL DIPLOMACY

On Wednesday 20 April 2016, a group of students in Political Science has organised a workshop on the practices of organising conferences in various topics like the Syrian crisis and the civil war in Yemen. The workshop was facilitated by Dr Khaleel Al Samarae, an Associate Professor at the department of Political Science and the instructor of the course titled "Diplomacy in Theory and Practice". Each student of the group was allocated a country to be its diplomatic representative in a playing role to discuss the problems and consequences of the Syrian crisis; as well as the current civil war in Yemen. This workshop has given the students a great opportunity to exercise their skills in diplomacy in terms of language and expression, and to learn how to be involved in dialogues at an international level.
