


28. First Virtual Open Day



32. Virtual Meeting with the Computer Science Student Employers and Alumni



33. A Virtual Open Day



Public Outreach

1. Visiting London South Bank University (UK)

Adelegation from Applied Science University visited London South Bank University in September 2019 to discuss matters relating to the ongoing partnership between the two Universities. ASU's delegation consisted of Professor Waheeb Al Khaja (the Chairman of ASU's Board of Trustees), Professor Ghassan Aouad (ASU's President), Mr Abdulla Al Khaja (Director of Administration and Finance) and Ms Catherine Hogan (Head of International Partnerships). The ASU delegation had fruitful meetings with the Vice-Chancellor of LSBU Professor David Phoenix, the Deputy Vice-Chancellor Professor Paul Ivey and many other senior colleagues. The discussions spanned institutional and national updates, partnership management and collaboration on academic degrees, joint research and staff development activities. The ASU and LSBU partnership was established in 2014 and covered a range of activities. In September 2017, the first students were admitted to the LSBU degrees hosted at ASU (in Architectural Design Engineering and Civil and Construction Engineering). Several more degrees are planned to open in September 2020. On the research side, ASU faculty collaborate with LSBU faculty on joint research projects relevant to Bahrain's national priority for renewal energy solutions (one on the relationship between roof shapes, energy consumption and thermal comfort and the other on integrating wind turbines in the built environment). Staff development activities include leadership development, teaching strategies in Higher Education and other topics designed to enhance the student experience. Future plans for the partnership include summer schools, study abroad schemes for students and staff exchange schemes. ASU and LSBU are also construction engineering their second international research conference - the International Conference on Innovation, Technology, Enterprise and Entrepreneurship will be held in Bahrain on November 24th and 25th, 2019. ASU has recently been awarded Accreditation by Bahrain's Higher Education Council and its courses have achieved confidence status from Bahrain's Quality Assurance Authority. In international rankings, ASU has reached #45 in the QS Arab Region University Rankings 2019; the 301+ category of the University Impact Rankings 2019; and the 601+ category (and #25 in Arab region) in the UI GreenMetric World University Ranking 2018 – all three are the highest placing among Bahrain's private Universities in all the rankings. HEA Fellowships have now been awarded to 53 of our staff in recognition of professional standards in supporting student learning. In addition, ASU's students won University Company of the Year in the Young Entrepreneurs Competition 2019, organised by INJAZ Bahrain. Like ASU, LSBU is a student-centred University with a focus on entrepreneurship and employability. LSBU has a Silver rating in the UK Government's Teaching Excellence Framework and was awarded University of the Year for Graduate Employment in 2018.



2. Mid-Point Visit





On April 21st, 2020, ASU passed the second surveillance audit for its quality management system and successfully retained its ISO 9001:2015 Certification to provide administrative support for its students. The 2nd Surveillance Audit comes about two years after the University first achieved the ISO 9001:2015 Certification back in 2018 and one year after it successfully passed its 1st Surveillance Audit.

The Surveillance Audits are meant to verify that all the measures taken to install a robust Quality Management System are still in place, properly implemented and monitored, and are effectively leading to continuous improvement.

The External Audit was performed by a Senior External Auditor appointed by RICI, the IRCA (UK) Approved Certification Body that inspected the University and granted it the certification in the first place.

This year, the External Audit was conducted virtually through a purpose-built virtual audit room. It consisted of live interviews with the selected departments and to documents' inspection based on sampling and audit trailing techniques.


After an opening meeting chaired by the VP for Administration, Finance and Community Engagement with the External Auditor and all the Heads of Departments selected for the External Surveillance Audit, the External Auditor started conducting his virtual interviews with the top management and the departments chosen as per the scheduled plan, including the QAAC, the HR Department, the Deanship of Student Affairs, and examining various documentation related to these departments and other departments such as the Marketing and Public Relations Directorate.

The technology deployed by the University allowed the external auditor to conduct his mission very smoothly, and he was delighted with the way things were run. He finally held a closing meeting at the end of the day to thank everyone for their valuable cooperation and confirmed that after his day-long audit activities, he concluded that the quality management system installed two years ago as per the ISO 9001:2015 standard is properly up and running and therefore, he recommends the University to keep its certification. The attendees cheered for this great news and thanked him for his fine work and professionalism and took a virtual group photo.


This achievement comes as yet another testimonial of the University's strong commitment to achieving high-quality standards, achieving continuous improvement, and above all, achieving student satisfaction.

ASU is the First Private University in the Kingdom, in terms of global ranking, to be placed alongside other world-class Universities. This accolade has been awarded by the QS World University Rankings. QS World University Rankings is an Annual Publication of University Rankings by Quacquarelli Symonds (QS), and it is one of the world's most distinguished University Ranking Organisations.

ASU has occupied this advanced position in the QS Rankings for the second time. It achieved an advanced position for Arab Universities with the QS Arab Region University Rankings over the past two years. In the 2018/2019 rankings, ASU ranked 45th Place in the QS Arab Region, while in the 2019/2020 rankings it advanced to 37th Place and became the only University in the Kingdom of Bahrain to receive four stars. 
