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

The College of Engineering has planned and arranged several visits this semester to various projects in the Kingdom of Bahrain for the students enrolled in the Civil and Architectural Engineering programmes. Students will be given the opportunity to visit some projects at different stages in the construction process and will be provided with an explanation of the design and construction cycles from inception to completion.

Dr. Hamdy Alsayed, Acting Head of Internship Unit and Programme Director, and Ms. Safa Awawdeh, Research and Teaching Assistant, in the College of Engineering have been leading, supervising, planning, assisting and managing these visits with the help and support from the college's Acting Dean and Head of Department.

Communications with several construction companies have been conducted early to identify firms with project site visit opportunities for students of the Civil and Architectural Engineering Programmes.

Seven site visits have been scheduled to be conducted at unique and top ranked projects: AMAS North Islands Apartments, Bahrain Precast Concrete Factory, First Energy Bank Tower, Bahrain New Exhibition and Convention Center, Alnaseem Project – Phase II, King Hamad American Mission Hospital – A'ali, and Solartecc Green Energy Factory. The university has received approval from the HEC for these visits.

On November 3th, students from the Civil and Architectural Engineering programmes have participated the first visit to Bahrain Precast Concrete (BPC) Factory under the supervision of Dr. Hamdy Alsayed, Ms. Safa Awawdeh, and Mr. Yusuf Buzaboon. BPC is considered as the pioneer of precast concrete in the region, they have established a thriving business that has revolutionized the Gulf construction industry. BPC's projects portfolio has decades of experience in design, production and erection of precast concrete elements for building projects across the GCC.

The engineering students have visited different departments in the factory and attended to the explanation from the company's engineers. All students have confirmed their appreciation and satisfaction for the great opportunity and practical skills offered to them by the hosting company.

Student Noor Jasim stated: "I really enjoyed my time there; it was a beneficial experience". Student Jumana Altaweel commented that "the site visit was really interesting. I enjoyed seeing the processes inside the factory rather than only studying the theoretical aspects". The students acknowledged the importance of the practical skills and experiences in the field of Civil and Architectural Engineering

Link tutors work hand in hand with ASU colleagues to maintain the quality of the programmes, share best learning and teaching practices, offer advice on assessment design, and provide recommendations for enhancing various aspects of the programme delivery and management.

Among the topics discussed was the external examination process which is currently done via emails. The IPO suggested that the external moderation process is done through the robust ASU exam moderation portal which has proven to be successful throughout the years. LSBU colleagues welcomed this idea that would facilitate the operations.

In the same week a meeting was scheduled with the IT department at ASU where colleagues confirmed that this update to the moderation portal would be possible and will be piloted in the second semester for the Civil and Architecture programmes, as the other programmes which are in their foundation year do not require external moderation of the assessment.

The meetings were very successful. Colleagues were put able to put names into faces, and inperson visits of the link tutors were also discussed with tentatively aiming for January 2023.





#### **ASU Participation APG School University Fair**
