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




























College of Engineering Workshop Series started 23 November, AY 2022-23

Based on the University key performance indicators (KPI) and the College of Engineering operational plan, in the Learning and Teaching Development area and the Student Support area, the College of Engineering has initiated a series of workshops to fulfil the college's objective of 'Enhance Student's Performance'. The first workshop in the AY 2022-23 held on 23 November, was introduced based on the students' desire to increase their practical market skills. Dr Wael Abdelhameed offered the workshop, explaining the computer program, 3ds max, with the attendance of graduates from 2020-21 and 2021-22, as well as our current students from levels S to 5.

The 3ds max program workshop is offered for beginners and intermediate users. Dr Wael started with explaining how architects start designing, and how they use manual and digital tools to translate their thoughts into functional relationships and forms. The explanation extended to cover the use of the 3ds max program as a design tool in the early phases of the design process, proceeding with making forms and masses, and demonstrating manipulation of geometrical forms of different types: primitive, mesh, and editable poly.

The attendees' testimonies were highly positive and were in favour of having more workshops throughout the academic year. The 2021-22 Architectural Engineering programme Graduate, Architectural Engineer, Mohamed Ali, asked to have more workshops covering the same program with the focus of materials and lighting. Architectural Engineer, Sara Ibrahim, graduate of 2020-21, appreciated the initiative from the college of Engineering, and suggested to cover more computer programs that are used in the market. The Level 5 Students, Lilian Abuidrees and Nada Khalifa, shared the view that this will help them in their current modules and prepare them to accumulate market skills.

16 students and graduates attended the workshop; some of which were online as the program screen was shared through the university system. The recording was made available for the attendees. This intiation by the collegemmaintains and strengthens the relationships with its graduates, and also improves the current students' skills and capabilities, which are required in the job market.







"Intellectual Property in Higher Education Institutions"

The Deanship of Research and Graduate Studies held a scientific seminar entitled "Intellectual Property in Higher Education Institutions" delivered by Dr. Nassim Al-Shawawrah from the Faculty of Law. He talked about topics that included: An introduction to the concept of intellectual property and its basic elements, the importance of using intellectual property and managing it efficiently, the basic elements included in copyright as one of the elements of intellectual property, especially based on learning in the digital environment. 
