
Forum 4: Sharing "Online Teaching Practices" During (COVID 19)



The 4th Forum organized by The Academic Staff Development Unit (ASDU), Academic year 2019-2020







This year the University, as all Universities around the globe, has experienced unprecedented situation due to the pandemic "Covid 19". Following the social distancing imposed by the Kingdom of Bahrain and in order to pursue the student's education without interruption, ASU has shifted its education to "Online learning teaching and assessment" as an emergency alternative for a safe educational environment. During this emergency shift to new teaching approach, many academics found online teaching, learning and assessment quite challenging and dealt with it in a various ways and means, other academics found it quite fulfilling and developed innovative and creative virtual teaching ideas and used various tools and techniques along with ensuring students interaction, and meeting the intended learning outcomes.
