
- 1. A committee will be formed and chaired by the President in order to plan for the new academic year including all health and safety precautions. This is a request by the Ministry of Education.

- 12. Academic staff should mainly target Scopus indexed journals when appropriate for the academic discipline.

- 14. Quality should be at the heart in everything we do including course portfolios, lesson plans, delivery of courses, research, community engagement, infrastructure, processes and procedures and other quality related issues.
- 15. Strong leadership should be provided at all levels in order to sustain our success. Academic Programme coordinators should play a major role in ensuring top quality for their academic programmes resulting in great successes in programme reviews and NQF placements.
- 16. We should all be involved in students recruitment and retention as these require collective efforts.
- 17. The Strategic Plan 2020-2025 needs to be finalized before the end of September 2020.
- 18. The HEC End of Year Report needs to be submitted by the end of September 2020.
- 19. The HEC monthly August report should be submitted before the end of this week.
