Green Metric Rankings

It is really pleasing to see our new position in the recently published Green Metric Rankings. We have been ranked by the Greenmetric (2020 Universities Worldwide Ranking) 484 out of 911 participating universities from around the world for this year compared to 780 participating universities last year, as for the Arab region, we are ranked 37 out of 106 participating Arab universities for this year which is an improvement compared to last year Arab region rank. With this ranking, we are the only private university in Bahrain that participated in this ranking, as for the University of Bahrain was ranked 430 in the World and 33 in the Arab region. Based on the details in the table above, we have improved by 152 places compared to last year in the worldwide ranking, this improvement came along with an increase of 131 participating university compared to last year. We also improved by 8 places in the Arab region ranking, this improvement also came along with an increase of 25 participating Arab universities compared to last year.

Book Review: Exploring Entrepreneurship (2017)

Today I would like to share with you the textbook of one of my MBA courses at Strathclyde University, which is "Exploring Entrepreneurship", 2nd Edition, 2017 (the course being "Entrepreneurship and Leadership Management"). The book is authored by Professor Richard Blundel (The Open University), Professor Nigel Lockett (University of Strathclyde) and Professor Catherine Wang (Brunel University London) and published by Sage Publishing.

What makes this textbook special is that it covers both the theoretical and practical aspects of entrepreneurship with plenty of case studies, examples and interviews with real life entrepreneurs. It is split into 2 parts: PART I Entrepreneurship in Practice, and PART II Perspectives on Entrepreneurship. Together, they enable students to understand the theoretical perspectives of entrepreneurship, and how these can be applied to practice.


