
### PRESIDENT'S NEWS DIGEST

With the present simple tense, we often use adverbs of frequency to say 'how often' we do something. Here's a list of common adverbs:

Adverb	%	Example
Always	100%	My friend is very punctual. She <b>always</b> arrives on time.
Usually	90%	I usually go to bed around 11pm. Usually I go to bed around 11pm. I go to bed around 11pm usually.
Frequently	75%	I frequently wash my hair. Frequently I wash my hair. I wash my hair frequently.
Often	60%	I <b>often</b> eat meat. Often I eat meat. I eat meat often.
Sometimes	50%	I sometimes watch TV after work. Sometimes I watch TV after work. I watch TV after work sometimes.
Occasionally	40%	He occasionally skips breakfast. Occasionally he skips breakfast. He skips breakfast occasionally.
Rarely	20%	My best friend lives abroad. I rarely see her.
Never	0%	She <b>never</b> eats meat.
