### QS World University Rankings 2023, well done ASU

The QS World University Rankings 2023 has been announced and we are now ranked at 561-570 up from 591-600 in the World last year and 651-700 the year before. This great achievement demonstrates a sustained performance and it is good for us and the higher education sector in the Kingdom of Bahrain. The results were announced in New York at the EduData Summit and attended by myself and VP Dr Mohamed Yousif.

I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate all of you for this fantastic achievement and to thank Prof Waheeb for his vision and continuous support and Dr Mohamed Yousif and his team for their hard work, endless efforts and great leadership. We will celebrate this achievement soon inshallah.

Featuring 1422 universities from around the world, this year's university rankings are the largest ever. Each institution has been assessed according to six key metrics:

1. Academic Reputation (40%)
2. Employer Reputation (10%)
3. Faculty/Student Ratio (20%)
4. Citations per faculty (20%)
5. International Faculty Ratio (5%)
6. International Student Ratio (5%)

There are 80 Arab Universities featuring in the QS World University Ranking, ASU is number 17th in the Arab World.

Let's keep up the good work and make our University shine even more.

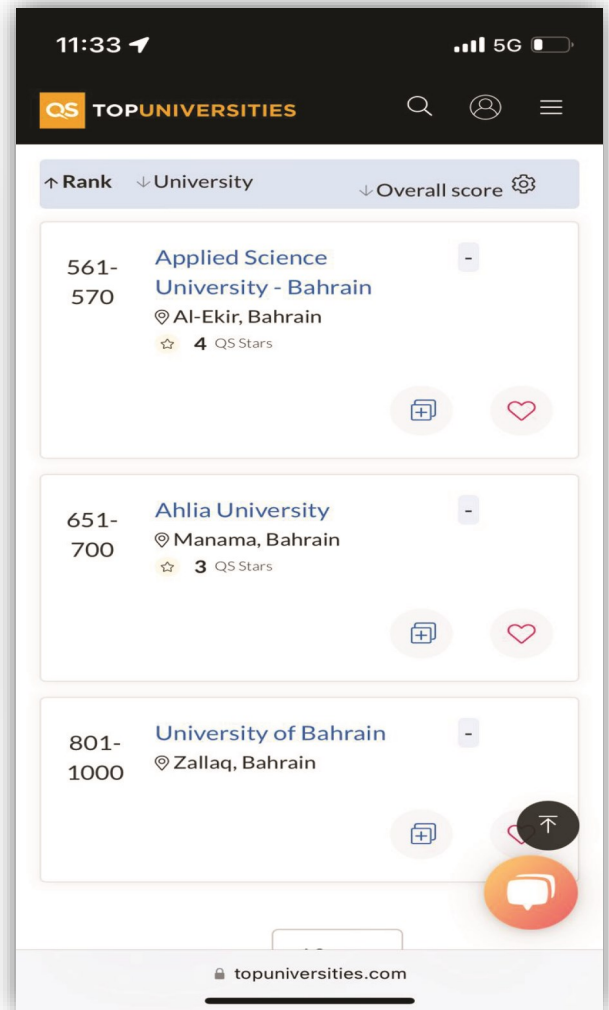
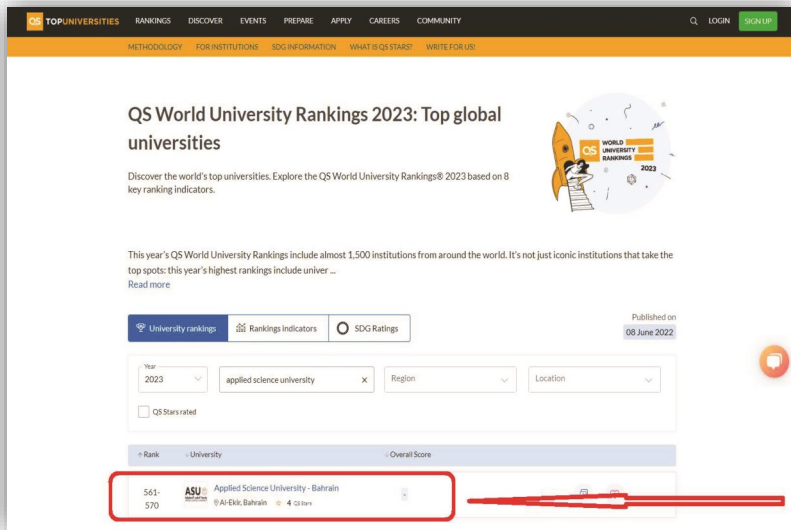

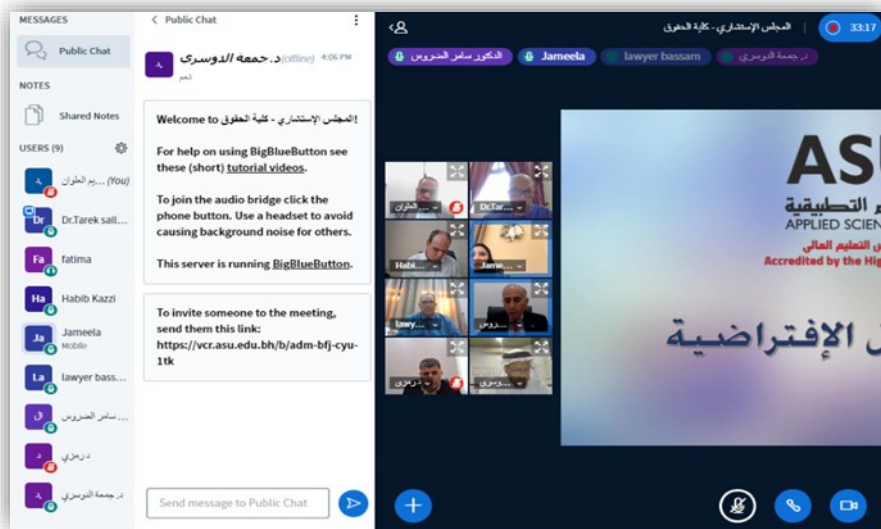

## College of Engineering Students' Internship Activities - Summer 2022

The internship module is intended to provide students at the University with the opportunity to apply what they are learning in their academic courses to real-world projects. This module provides the students with an opportunity to experience the industrial world and be part of a team working on real world projects. The internship unit at the College of Engineering assists each student to find the most suitable industry. It aims to provide students with real-life work experience related the their academic programme.

The college emphasizes that practical experience in a professional setting is essential to the comprehensive development of the students' skills, knowledge, and abilities. The internship module is intended to reinforce their learning by giving the students an opportunity to gain practical experience in applying academic concepts, as stated in the ASU Student Internship Policy. In addition, the internship program enables students to understand their own strengths and weaknesses in the workplace, work with people from other cultures, and give them confidence that they can make the transition from the classroom to the workplace comfortably.

During the second semester, the internship plan has been prepared for the prospective students who are now enrolled in the internship module during the summer semester. The communications with over 40 companies have been conducted to identify firms with internship opportunities for students of Level 5 in the Civil and Architectural Engineering Programmes. We have a total of 19 students participating in the internship program this year.

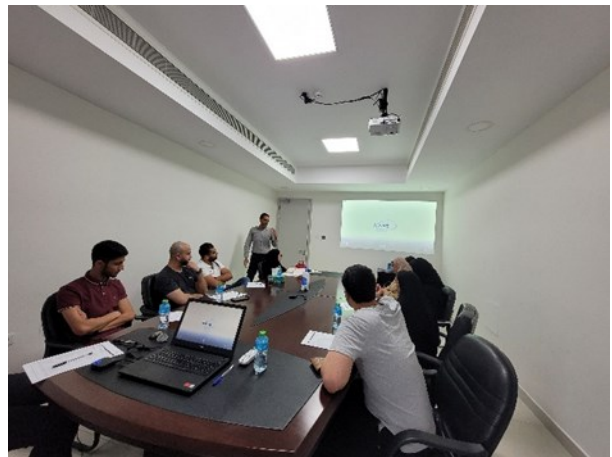
